4 Class 2A All-State Teams; and

6 surgery sidelined her for the first 15 games of the 2014-2015
7 season, Jayci Padgett made a fierce comeback in December to help
8 lead the Lady Eagles to their 20th consecutive 20-win year and a
9 playoff berth; in the postseason, she averaged 18 points a game
10 during her team's march to the quarterfinals, where her season drew
11 to a close with a hard-fought 60-42 loss against Windthorst High
12 School; and

13 WHEREAS, In addition to garnering All-State honors for the
14 third consecutive year, this talented center was recognized for her
15 inspired play on the hardwood by being named to the TABC and TGCA
16 Academic All-State Teams, the TABC Class 2A All-Region II Team, and
17 the *Abilene Reporter-News* Class 2A All-Big Country first team; and

18 WHEREAS, Benefiting from the guidance of head coach Angie
19 Hermesmeier, this dedicated student-athlete has established
20 herself as one of the top 2A basketball players in the Lone Star
21 State, and she may indeed take justifiable pride in this
22 accomplishment; now, therefore, be it
