7 the City of Midland two years later, initially working as assistant
8 city attorney before being promoted to first assistant city
9 attorney in 1985; he also served as assistant city manager from 1989

12 appointed as the city attorney in Sugar Land; he returned home to
13 Midland the following year, when he began his distinguished tenure
14 as city attorney; through the years, he excelled in his

16 colleagues in city government; in all his endeavors, he enjoys the
17 support and encouragement of his wife, Sheryl, and his daughter,
18 Amy; and
