- 17 tirelessly on many political campaigns, helping to elect candidates
- 18 for offices ranging from constable to the state legislature to
- 19 Congress; she served on the State Democratic Executive Committee
- 20 and on the boards of the Tarrant County Stonewall Democrats and the
- 21 Tarrant County Central Labor Council; she was also a valued member
- 22 of former State Representative Lon Burnam's staff; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Edwards was a Yellow Rose of Texas and a member
- 24 of the Daughters of the American Revolution; she was also active in

- 1 the LGBT community and a member of the Communications Workers of
- 2 America; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Mary Edwards gave freely of her time, expertise, and
- 4 energy to better her community and to support the causes in which
- 5 she believed, and she leaves behind a record of service that her
- 6 loved ones can remember with pride; now, therefore, be it
