RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Many retired Texas game wardens and their spouses 2 are visiting Austin on May 20, 2015, to celebrate Retired Texas Game Warden Day at the State Capitol and to commemorate the 120 years of 3 dedicated service that game wardens have provided to the Lone Star 4 5 State; and WHEREAS, Since 1895, when the office of Fish and Oyster 6 7 Commissioner was created by the 24th Texas Legislature, game wardens have played an essential role in wildlife conservation; the 8 9 Fish and Oyster Commission was given jurisdiction in 1899 over all public waters, including freshwater streams, lakes, and ponds, and 10 11 its purview was soon extended to shrimping and hunting; the name of 12 the agency later became the Game, Fish, and Oyster Commission, and it changed again several times to reflect the expansion of its 13 14 mission until, in 1963, it merged with the State Parks Board to form the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department; and 15 16 WHEREAS, In the early years, there were just six wardens, but their numbers grew as their duties continued to 17 evolve, encompassing such tasks as the promotion of recreational water 18 safety and the apprehension of criminals involved in a range of 19 illegal activities in addition to wildlife law violations; Texas 20 21 A&M University established the Texas Game Warden Academy in 1946, and 14 cadets attended that first formal game warden training; in 22 23 1971, the legislature formally recognized as peace officers all law

enforcement officers within the TPWD; the state is presently served
