6 work in many venues, and he is very involved in the local cultural
7 scene; and

9 the San Elizario Historic District in the Mission Valley, which
10 draws many visitors to its artist studios, galleries, gift shops,
11 restaurants, and other attractions; the recipient of the 2010
12 McDonald's Hispanos Triunfadores Award for the arts, he has served
13 as president of the El Paso Art Association and as a member of the
14 Rio Bravo Watercolorists Society and the Juntos Art Association,
