WHEREAS, This accomplished Texan has consistently worked for 15 16 the betterment of his community and state by taking an active role in a number of worthy groups, including the El Paso Chamber of 17 Commerce, the Texas Business Leadership Council, and the Steering 18 Committee of the Borderplex Regional Economic Alliance; in 2007, 19 20 Governor Rick Perry appointed him to The University of Texas System 21 Board of Regents, which he led as vice chair beginning in 2009 and has served as chair since 2013; he also served as chair of The 22 23 University of Texas Investment Management Company Board of Directors; and 24
