- 1 WHEREAS, Private First Class Wesley Robert Riggs of Baytown
- 2 died on May 17, 2005, at the age of 19, while bravely serving in
- 3 Iraq, but the spirit of this valiant young Texan continues to live
- 4 on in the hearts of those who were privileged to know him; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Born in Baytown on August 16, 1985, Wesley Riggs was
- 6 the son of Gayle McDermott and Daniel Riggs; growing up on the Gulf
- 7 Coast, he enjoyed his time on the water fishing and rafting with his
- 8 friends, and he was noted for his love of camping, tinkering with
- 9 cars, mudding, and all things Southern; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Riggs went on to graduate from Barbers Hill High
- 11 School in 2003 and enlisted in the United States Army in February of
- 12 the following year; he was assigned to the 2nd Battalion, 7th
- 13 Infantry Regiment, 3rd Infantry Division, out of Fort Stewart,
- 14 Georgia, and was ultimately deployed in support of Operation Iraqi
- 15 Freedom; highly regarded for his strong work ethic and
- 16 dependability, he uplifted his comrades with his can-do attitude
- 17 when they faced particularly daunting challenges, and he had a
- 18 knack for orchestrating practical jokes; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Private Riggs was mortally wounded in Tikrit, Iraq,
- 20 after an improvised explosive device detonated near his position;
- 21 his loss left an immeasurable void in the lives of countless
- 22 friends, family, and fellow soldiers, and in tribute to his memory,
- 23 a scholarship fund has been established in his name; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Private Wesley Riggs was a remarkable young man who
