1 WHEREAS, Dr. Cesar A. Arias of Bellaire, a researcher at The
2 University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, has been
3 elected to the American Society for Clinical Investigation; and

4 WHEREAS, One of the oldest and most recognized medical honor
5 societies in the United States, the American Society for Clinical
6 Investigation is composed of more than 3,000 physician-scientists
7 who are inducted into the organization for their scholarly
8 achievements in biomedical research; and

9 WHEREAS, An associate professor in the Division of Infectious
10 Diseases at The University of Texas Health Science Center,
11 Dr. Arias has focused his research on antibiotic-resistant strains
12 of bacteria known as superbugs, which infect and kill approximately
13 23,000 Americans each year; in addition to his work at UTHealth, he
14 serves as director of the Molecular Genetics and Antimicrobial
15 Resistance Unit at Universidad El Bosque in Colombia, South
16 America, and on the medical staffs of Lyndon B. Johnson Hospital
17 and Memorial Hermann-Texas Medical Center in Houston; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Cesar Arias is contributing greatly to the
19 advancement of research in a field of study with wide implications
20 for public health, and this prestigious recognition reflects the
21 high esteem in which he is held by his peers in the academic medical
22 community; now, therefore, be it
