## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Commander Partida was transferred to Patrol 17 Squadron 30 in 2003, and he later served for three years aboard the 18 USS Ronald Reagan, during which time the ship completed its maiden 19 20 deployment to the Arabian Gulf in support of the Global War on 21 Terror; he went on to join Patrol Squadron 1 before being assigned 22 2011 to the Joint Staff, Nuclear Command and Control in 23 Directorate, which he served as assistant deputy director for operations; and 24
