1 WHEREAS, Alexander Good-Suhm, a senior at Rapoport Academy
2 Meyer High School in Waco, participated in the Texas High School
3 Aerospace Scholars program at NASA during the summer of 2014; and

4 WHEREAS, The HAS program was established in 1999 as a
5 partnership between the State of Texas, NASA's Johnson Space Center
6 in Houston, and the Texas educational community to encourage
7 student interest in science, technology, engineering, and math
8 careers; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Good-Suhm was one of 260 high school juniors to
10 join in the weeklong program at Johnson Space Center; participants
11 toured the facilities, heard briefings by NASA experts, and
12 presented a jointly developed proposal for a mission to Mars to a
13 gathering of their parents, the space center's senior management,
14 members of the Texas Legislature, and representatives from the
15 Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo and the Rotary Club; and

16 WHEREAS, An exemplary scholar, Mr. Good-Suhm was named a
17 Commended Student for 2015 by the National Merit Scholarship
18 Program; he has worked as a research assistant at the Baylor
19 Research and Innovation Collaborative, and he plans to study
20 physics after graduating from Rapoport Academy Meyer High School;

22 WHEREAS, This fine young Texan is moving toward the front
23 ranks of the next generation of scientists and engineers, and he is
24 indeed a source of great pride to his family and his school; now,

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas

4 participation in the Texas High School Aerospace Scholars program
