    WHEREAS, Alexander Good-Suhm, a senior at Rapoport Academy Meyer High School in Waco, participated in the Texas High School Aerospace Scholars program at NASA during the summer of 2014; and

    WHEREAS, The HAS program was established in 1999 as a partnership between the State of Texas, NASA's Johnson Space Center in Houston, and the Texas educational community to encourage student interest in science, technology, engineering, and math careers; and

    WHEREAS, Mr. Good-Suhm was one of 260 high school juniors to join in the weeklong program at Johnson Space Center; participants toured the facilities, heard briefings by NASA experts, and presented a jointly developed proposal for a mission to Mars to a gathering of their parents, the space center's senior management, members of the Texas Legislature, and representatives from the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo and the Rotary Club; and
