R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Oran Lopez Reed of Boy Scouts of America Troop
2 No. 610 in Austin has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. Reed earned the requisite 21 merit badges, including
8 those requiring expertise in such areas as climbing, canoeing, and

18 scouting as a student at the Liberal Arts and Science Academy magnet
19 school and as a member of the LBJ Jaguars and East Austin Lone Stars

21 St. Edward's University, where he has earned a Presidential
22 Scholarship and been admitted into the Honors Program; and

23 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Reed's dedication to excellence and his
24 perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy to

1 stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride
2 on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

4 Legislature hereby congratulate Eagle Scout Oran Lopez Reed on
5 achieving this prestigious rank and extend to him sincere best
