WHEREAS, For 65 years, families of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in Houston have joined together to celebrate their faith; and

WHEREAS, Organized on June 26, 1950, the church was led by Father John Cummings, who oversaw an original congregation of approximately 700 families; the first church structure was completed in September of that same year, and the St. Francis of Assisi School was opened in 1955; a new sanctuary was dedicated in 1966 to accommodate the growing needs of the parish, and the church's membership has continued to flourish over the ensuing half-century; and

WHEREAS, Over the years, the church has also benefited from the able leadership of Fathers Robert Blankenstein, Alfred Greenwald, Joseph Culver, Marion Polker, Michael Doerflein, Thomas Miller, Patrick Wells, and Romanus Muoneke, and today, that tradition of service and support continues under the direction of Father Edmund Nnadozie; and
