5 1939, and through the decades, it has distinguished itself by
6 promoting outstanding academic achievement while enabling young
7 people to share in a rich sense of community; and

8 WHEREAS, Today, Bryker Woods students benefit from the
9 dedicated efforts of principal Jane Kronke and the other members of
10 the faculty, and the school is one of only a limited number of
11 elementary campuses in the Austin Independent School District that
12 continue to serve children from kindergarten through grade six; and

14 neighborhood, the school has helped preserve the area's natural
15 beauty by caring for the numerous heritage live oak trees that shade
16 the school grounds; moreover, the school's installation of solar
17 panels, a rain water collection system, and an organic garden have

19 responsibility, and it has received a "green school" designation
20 for its accomplishments; and
