1           WHEREAS, The Salt Lick in Driftwood brought its savory  
2 specialties to the State Capitol during the 84th Legislative  
3 Session as one of the featured restaurants for "Bar-B-Quesday"; and

4           WHEREAS, Hosted on Tuesdays by State Representative Jason  
5 Isaac, this popular event provides a showcase for some of the finest  
6 barbecue establishments from House District 45; and

7           WHEREAS, The Salt Lick got its start in 1967, when Thurman  
8 Roberts, a third-generation resident of Driftwood, began following  
9 his grandmother's recipe and slow-cooking barbecue over coals and  
10 offering it for sale each weekend; his brisket, sausage, turkey,  
11 and pork and beef ribs proved such a hit that the operation soon  
12 developed into a full-time restaurant; today, The Salt Lick is run  
13 by Thurman's son, Scott, and it draws thousands of customers each  
14 week, not only at the original Driftwood location but also at its  
15 outlets in Round Rock, Austin, and Oklahoma City; and

16           WHEREAS, Texas barbecue is renowned across the nation and  
17 around the world, and this proud culinary tradition is maintained  
18 and enriched by outstanding Central Texas businesses such as The  
19 Salt Lick; now, therefore, be it
