R E S O L U T I O N

2 passing of Albert Edward Baade Jr. of Tyler on April 6, 2014, at the
3 age of 87; and

4 WHEREAS, Albert Baade was born in Dallas on April 30, 1926, to
5 Albert E. Baade Sr. and Jewell Bryant Baade; he served the United
6 States Navy with distinction in the Pacific theater during World
7 War II, earning two battle stars for his efforts, and after he
8 returned home, he earned his bachelor's degree from Baylor
9 University; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Baade began his career in the oil industry as an
11 oil scout, working with his uncle, W. T. Bryant; a respected member
12 of the profession, he was a founding member of the East Texas
13 Association of Petroleum Landmen and an original board member of
14 the Tyler Petroleum Club; later, he was employed as the dean of
15 continuing education at Tyler Junior College, where he helped to
16 develop and organize a curriculum for the real estate and petroleum
17 landman program; and

18 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Baade enjoyed the love and
19 support of his wife, Elizabeth, with whom he shared 64 years before
20 her passing; he was also the proud father of a son, William, and as
21 his extended family grew, he delighted in spending time with his
22 grandchildren, Brandon, Carolyn, and Alexandra, and his
23 great-grandchildren, Savannah and William; and

24 WHEREAS, Although Albert Baade is deeply missed, memories of

1 his good humor, his enthusiasm, and his quiet strength remain to
2 comfort and inspire those he leaves behind; now, therefore, be it
