R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Texas Heritage National Bank celebrated the 125th  
2 anniversary of its founding in 2014, and its locations in  
3 Daingerfield, Omaha, Ore City, and Sulphur Springs commemorated  
4 this noteworthy milestone throughout the month of May; and

5           WHEREAS, On the first day of May in 1889, nine citizens of  
6 Daingerfield pooled their capital and formed the Bank of  
7 Daingerfield, with total assets of \$26,000; three years later, the  
8 bank received a national charter and was renamed the National Bank  
9 of Daingerfield; and

10           WHEREAS, Over the next century, the bank's assets grew to \$43  
11 million; after a series of acquisitions and expansions, new  
12 branches were established in Omaha, Ore City, and Sulphur Springs,  
13 and the bank became Texas Heritage National Bank; and

14           WHEREAS, In 2014, THNB had \$110 million in assets and a  
15 diversified loan portfolio of \$80 million; under the leadership of  
16 chair John Bryan, vice chair Danny Bockmon, and CEO and president  
17 Dwyatt Bell, THNB continues to thrive as a community bank,  
18 providing financial support and services to families, businesses,  
19 farmers, and ranchers; and

20           WHEREAS, Locally owned financial institutions play a vital  
21 role in the economy and culture of Texas, and by carrying on its  
22 proud traditions of meeting the needs of its customers and serving  
23 the community, Texas Heritage National Bank is indeed deserving of  
24 special recognition; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
2 Legislature hereby commemorate the 125th anniversary of Texas  
3 Heritage National Bank and extend to all those associated with the  
4 bank sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it further

5           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
6 prepared for the bank as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
7 House of Representatives.
