2 a close with the passing of Mayde Elizabeth McGinty of Caldwell  
3 County on April 23, 2015, while she was visiting Ireland, the home  
4 of her ancestors; and

5           WHEREAS, Born in Crockett on March 26, 1940, Liz McGinty  
6 graduated from Texas Christian University and taught physical  
7 education in the Austin Independent School District before her  
8 retirement; she lived in Caldwell County for more than three  
9 decades, and she was a tireless advocate for women, children,  
10 education, the arts, and the environment; and

11           WHEREAS, Ms. McGinty was very active in the Caldwell County  
12 Democratic Party, and she served as a precinct chair and election  
13 judge; in addition, she was president of the Texas Democratic Women  
14 of Caldwell County for 2013 and 2014, and she was serving as the  
15 vice president of the Caldwell County Tejano Democrats; and

16           WHEREAS, A valued member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church,  
17 Ms. McGinty became a volunteer for Habitat for Humanity through her  
18 church involvement, and she served on the team that constructed  
19 Habitat's first home in Caldwell County; and

20           WHEREAS, Liz McGinty touched many lives through her activism  
21 and volunteer work, and she will forever hold a special place in the  
22 hearts of all who were fortunate enough to know her; now, therefore,
