2 Paso took top honors in its division at the United States Chess
3 Federation National Junior High Championship in April 2015; and

4 WHEREAS, Competing in the middle school novice category at
5 the Galt House in Louisville, Kentucky, the team received important
6 contributions from each player as they outmaneuvered their foes to
7 claim the first-place trophy; with the victory, the Henderson chess
8 team became the first squad from an El Paso school to win a USCF
9 national title; and

11 sixth place, and he was joined in the top 20 by Brandon Caballero in
12 13th place, Chris Carmona in 14th place, Rene Rodriguez in 15th

14 and Jose Vanegas in 19th place; also contributing to the
15 championship triumph were Lirio Gomez, Steven Mejia, Manny Tejada,
16 Francisco Marquez, and Joshua Valero; moreover, each student
17 benefited greatly throughout the year from guidance provided by HMS
18 chess coach Saul Ramirez; and

20 High Championship, the members of the Henderson Middle School chess
21 team proudly represented their school, and the dedication the
22 students have demonstrated is sure to serve them well in the years
