Intergovernmental Affairs, and in 1998, she was nominated by the

- 3 officer of the New America Alliance, and from 2009 to 2014, she was
- 4 senior vice president for external relations and general counsel

- 7 enhanced by the devoted efforts of individuals such as Regina
- 8 Montoya, whose tireless work has contributed immeasurably to the
