1 WHEREAS, Those Texans who give freely of their time and 2 talents to benefit their fellow citizens make the world a better place through their actions and their example, and Regina Montoya 3 of Dallas is being recognized for her exceptional community service 4 5 by being named a recipient of a 2015 Profiles in Leadership Award; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Ms. Montoya is co-chair of Dallas Mayor Mike Rawlings's Task Force on Poverty as well as a member of the 8 9 Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport board of directors; a longtime leader in the nonprofit community, she has also served on 10 the boards of Girls Inc., the Texas Book Festival, Texas Health 11 12 Presbyterian Hospital Dallas, ChildCareGroup, the Texas Business Hall of Fame, the Retina Foundation of the Southwest, and the Dallas 13 14 Friday Group; her many honors include the Dallas Minority Business Leader Award from the Dallas Business Journal, the Real Woman Award 15 16 from the Girl Scouts of Northeast Texas, the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Texas Minority Counsel Program of the State Bar of 17 Texas, and the Pioneer for Justice Award from the Mexican American 18 Bar Foundation; and 19 WHEREAS, A graduate of Harvard Law School, Ms. Montoya was 20 21 among the first Latinas to earn partnership in a major American corporate law firm; she served in the White House in 1993 as an 22 23 assistant to President Bill Clinton and as director of the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs, and in 1998, she was nominated by the 24

- 2 General Assembly; from 2005 to 2008, she was the chief executive
- 3 officer of the New America Alliance, and from 2009 to 2014, she was
- 4 senior vice president for external relations and general counsel
- 5 for the Children's Medical Center of Dallas; and

- 7 enhanced by the devoted efforts of individuals such as Regina
- 8 Montoya, whose tireless work has contributed immeasurably to the
- 9 quality of life in Dallas; now, therefore, be it
