13 vehicle; and

14 WHEREAS, Dogie Days events raise tens of thousands of dollars
15 each year, with the funds used to buy eyeglasses for those in need
16 and also to support a range of other worthwhile charitable causes,
17 including Leader Dogs for the Blind and the Texas Lions Camp; and

18 WHEREAS, The celebration is part of the beneficial work that
19 has been carried out by the Dumas Noon Lions Club since it was first
20 chartered in 1930; today, the club's members continue to be
21 dedicated to the motto "We Serve," and their work has a positive and
22 far-reaching influence on local citizens; and

23 WHEREAS, Dogie Days is a fun and much-anticipated
24 get-together that reflects the strong community spirit of Dumas,
