1 WHEREAS, Matthew Carlson of The University of Texas at Austin
2 Cockrell School of Engineering has been named a recipient of a
3 National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship; and

4 WHEREAS, Currently a senior, Mr. Carlson will receive three
5 years of financial support for his graduate studies within a
6 five-year fellowship period; the grant includes both a \$34,000
7 annual stipend and a yearly cost-of-education allowance to the
8 school; and

10 1952; it supports research in science, technology, engineering, and
11 mathematics by identifying students early in their graduate careers
12 based on academic achievements and their potential for advancing
13 knowledge in their disciplines; and
