1 WHEREAS, Korey Buscha rendered exceptional service to this
2 country over the course of an exemplary 13-year career in the U.S.
3 Marine Corps; and

4 WHEREAS, Raised in La Grange by his grandparents, Margie
5 Buscha and the late Matt Buscha, Mr. Buscha was inspired to join the
6 military by his grandfather, a veteran of the U.S. Army; so eager
7 was he to enlist that he took extra classes in high school in order
8 to attend basic training in California during his senior year; he
9 graduated from boot camp and from La Grange High School on the same
10 day; and

11 WHEREAS, After receiving training as an engineer and heavy
12 equipment operator at Fort Leonard Wood in Missouri, Mr. Buscha
13 served five tours of duty overseas, three in Iraq and two in
14 Afghanistan; from 2007 to 2010, he taught young marines as an
15 instructor at Fort Leonard Wood; Mr. Buscha completed active duty
16 in February 2015 at the rank of staff sergeant; and

17 WHEREAS, Korey Buscha and his wife, Kristi, were joined in
18 matrimony in 2008; now the parents of two young daughters, they have
19 settled in La Grange, where Mr. Buscha is restoring the house that
20 his great-grandfather built; and

21 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to the
22 men and women of this nation's armed forces, and over the course of
23 his career, Korey Buscha embodied the highest ideals of the U.S.
24 Marine Corps; now, therefore, be it
