## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, With the passing of Charlotte Koehler Flynn on April 2 19, 2015, at the age of 96, the State of Texas lost a remarkable 3 citizen who devoted her life to serving the greater good; and WHEREAS, Born in St. Louis on March 28, 1919, to Charlotte 4 5 and Arnold Koehler, the former Charlotte Koehler was joined in matrimony to William Flynn on July 11, 1941, and the couple nurtured 6 7 a rewarding union that spanned more than six and a half decades until his passing; over the course of their marriage, they became 8 9 the parents of three children, Liz, Mary Lou, and Greg, and their family later grew to include two granddaughters, Kathryn and 10 11 Charlotte; and 12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Flynn graduated with a bachelor's degree in nursing from Washington University in St. Louis in 1941 and 13 14 subsequently worked as an operating room supervisor in Panama; she and her family frequently moved in support of her husband's career 15 16 in the U.S. Navy, and in 1970, they put down roots in Austin; and WHEREAS, A staunch advocate for social justice, Mrs. Flynn 17 championed rights for youth, women, the elderly, the poor, and the 18 disenfranchised; she was a founding member of the Austin chapter of 19 the Gray Panthers, and she greatly benefited the national 20 21 organization through her service as chair in the 1990s and as a spokesperson for its National Campaign for Universal Health Care; 22 23 moreover, she was active with the Texas Coalition for Juvenile Justice and the Austin Peace and Justice Coalition, and she was 24

- 1 involved in the Girl Scouts for more than 35 years; in her leisure
- 2 time, she enjoyed printmaking, and she was known for giving refuge
- 3 to deer, birds, and creatures of all kinds who found their way to
- 4 her loving home; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Charlotte Flynn was a woman of strength, compassion,
- 6 and deeply held ideals who remained engaged in the world throughout
- 7 her life and who found joy and inspiration in helping others; now,

- 10 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Charlotte Koehler
- 11 Flynn and extend sincere condolences to the members of her family:
