

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, L. E. Dussetschleger has greatly benefited Lee  
2 County through his many years of dedicated public service; and

3           WHEREAS, "Buster" Dussetschleger began his career in law  
4 enforcement with the Lee County Sheriff's Office; he subsequently  
5 became the city marshal for Lexington, and in 1980 he was elected to  
6 the first of eight terms as a Lee County constable; for a number of  
7 years, he also served as the county's emergency management  
8 coordinator and represented the county on the Homeland Security  
9 Task Force of the Capital Area Council of Governments; his  
10 extensive work with CAPCOG included longtime service as a member of  
11 the Law Enforcement Education Committee and as an instructor with  
12 the Regional Law Enforcement Academy; and

13           WHEREAS, During his tenure as constable, Mr. Dussetschleger  
14 earned a master peace officer's license, an instructor's license,  
15 and a civil proficiency certificate; he served as a board member for  
16 the Texas Justices of the Peace and Constables Association and as  
17 president of the Central Texas Justices of the Peace and Constables  
18 Association, and he was twice named Constable of the Year;  
19 moreover, he was a member of the Lexington Volunteer Fire  
20 Department for a quarter-century; he led that group as president,  
21 and he played a key role in the establishment of the Emergency  
22 Medical Service, helping to coordinate the purchase of the city's  
23 first ambulance; in all his endeavors, he has enjoyed the support  
24 and encouragement of his wife, Linda S. Dussetschleger; and

1           WHEREAS, Public servants improve the quality of life for  
2 their fellow citizens in innumerable ways, and Buster  
3 Dussetschleger has contributed significantly to the betterment of  
4 Lee County; now, therefore, be it

5           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
6 Legislature hereby honor Buster Dussetschleger for his long record  
7 of public service and extend to him sincere best wishes for the  
8 future; and, be it further

9           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
10 prepared for Mr. Dussetschleger as an expression of high regard by  
11 the Texas House of Representatives.
