1 WHEREAS, Residents of San Elizario are gathering on May 27,
2 2015, for the grand opening of the San Elizario City Hall; and

3 WHEREAS, Well known for its historic and cultural landmarks,
4 San Elizario has a population of some 13,500 people in El Paso
5 County; it was incorporated by a community-wide vote held on
6 November 5, 2013, and a mayor and city council were elected to lead
7 the newly designated city the following year; and

8 WHEREAS, The city hall, located in the historic district of
9 San Elizario, will serve as the center of government for municipal
10 officers and staff, including Mayor Maya Sanchez and alderpersons
11 Leticia Miranda, David Cantu, Miguel Najera Jr., Rebecca
12 Martinez-Juarez, and George Almanzar; the dedication ceremony for
13 the building will also feature the unveiling of the official city
14 seal; and

15 WHEREAS, Proudly calling itself "the newest city with the
16 oldest history in the state of Texas," the city of San Elizario is
17 preserving its rich heritage while working to build an even
18 brighter future for present and future generations, and it is
19 indeed a pleasure to join in recognizing this special milestone;
20 now, therefore, be it

22 Legislature hereby commemorate the opening of the San Elizario City
23 Hall and extend sincere best wishes to all those in attendance for
