test for the Tigers, as the team from Albany High built a

19 two-touchdown advantage after three quarters of play; Bremond

20 responded with three unanswered scores in the final frame, however,

22 top with 1:17 left in the contest; the defense then stood firm once

23 more, holding the opposing offense in check and clinching the

24 second state championship in school history; Mr. Paul was named the
