13 civilian during her husband's long military career, and her sense

of adventure served her well during their many years overseas; at

15 their last duty station in Panama, she learned Spanish, and she

16 seized the opportunity to travel on the Amazon River and explore the

17 rain forest as well; the couple retired in 1972 and returned to

18 Jefferson, where they restored the home built in 1885 by her

19 maternal grandfather, Captain Charles Gibbs Graham; in addition,

20 Mrs. Craver returned to journalism as a community columnist; and

21 WHEREAS, In the 1990s, Mrs. Craver became president of the

22 Opera House Theatre Players, collaborating with her daughter,

23 Marcia Thomas, the artistic and managing director; their production
