## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Each year, landfills across the state are loaded

2 with valuable materials that could otherwise be used for new

3 products or repurposed supplies; and

4 WHEREAS, This inefficient and unsustainable approach to

5 waste management can be remedied by developing zero waste plans,

6 which establish practical steps to reduce waste and to safely

reuse, recycle, or compost discarded products and packaging; and

8 WHEREAS, Zero waste policies help protect natural resources

by reducing carbon emissions and conserving raw materials for

10 remanufacturing; by implementing such policies, numerous

11 businesses, communities, and individuals have reported success in

12 diverting from 70 to 90 percent or more of their wastes from

13 landfills and incinerators; and

14 WHEREAS, In addition to promoting stewardship of the

15 environment, zero waste plans present an opportunity for economic

16 growth; according to the Environmental Protection Agency, for every

17 10,000 tons of solid waste kept out of landfills, up to 10 recycling

18 or 75 materials reuse jobs are created; moreover, such plans can

19 help businesses thrive; General Motors, for example, has reduced

20 its costs substantially and has increased profits by applying zero

21 waste practices; encouraged by these favorable results, cities

22 across the Lone Star State, including Austin, Dallas, Fort Worth,

23 and San Antonio, are planning or have formally adopted zero waste
