1           WHEREAS, Brandon Bray of China Spring High School claimed the  
2 2015 University Interscholastic League Class 4A state title in the  
3 pole vault at Mike A. Meyers Stadium in Austin, taking home the gold  
4 medal in that event for the second consecutive year; and

5           WHEREAS, Competing against the top competitors from around  
6 the state, Mr. Bray won with a vault of 17 feet to close out his high  
7 school career as the Class 4A state champion; the win capped off an  
8 impressive senior year in which he captured titles at the district  
9 and regional meets to secure his spot in the field at the state  
10 meet; and

11           WHEREAS, By excelling in his chosen sport, Mr. Bray has  
12 followed in the footsteps of his father, Jeff Bray, an All-American  
13 pole vaulter at Florida State University during the 1990s and his  
14 coach at China Spring; following his graduation, Mr. Bray plans to  
15 continue pole vaulting at the collegiate level at Texas Tech  
16 University; and

17           WHEREAS, In proving himself the finest Class 4A pole vaulter  
18 in Texas, this talented student-athlete has realized a  
19 well-deserved reward for his countless hours of hard work and  
20 enduring commitment to excellence; now, therefore, be it

21           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
22 Legislature hereby congratulate Brandon Bray on winning the 2015  
23 UIL Class 4A state title in the pole vault and extend to him sincere  
24 best wishes for continued success; and, be it further
