

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, EnviroEd of Corpus Christi is committed to promoting  
2 a cleaner environment by teaching the public to practice better  
3 stewardship; and

4           WHEREAS, An educational company, EnviroEd was established by  
5 Dr. Patricia Reinhardt Mondragon; she is a consultant and former  
6 teacher and administrator who has worked in both public and  
7 parochial schools, and she holds a doctorate in educational  
8 leadership from Texas A&M University--Kingsville; and

9           WHEREAS, The company has developed classes intended to teach  
10 code violators about taking responsibility for behaviors that  
11 negatively impact the environment; following the model of defensive  
12 driving courses, EnviroEd intends that these classes would allow  
13 those cited for code violations to receive valuable instruction in  
14 lieu of fines; topics addressed in its classes include the  
15 recycling of unwanted objects and disposal strategies for common  
16 toxic materials such as diapers, pet waste, tires, and cigarette  
17 butts; and

18           WHEREAS, Maintaining a safe and clean environment is vital to  
19 the community, and EnviroEd has created a business model that  
20 supports this important goal; now, therefore, be it

21           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
22 Legislature hereby recognize EnviroEd for its efforts to develop a  
23 free-market nongovernmental solution to environmental problems and  
24 extend to all those associated with the company sincere best wishes
