9 president of the Dallas Park and Recreation Board, and as the first

12 and Criminal Justice; currently, Mr. Dunning is serving on the
13 boards of the Baylor Health Care System Foundation, the Southern
14 Methodist University Tower Center for Political Studies, The
15 Bridge, North Dallas Shared Ministries, and Greenhill School; and

16 WHEREAS, Over the years, Mr. Dunning has received a number of
17 prestigious accolades, including the Linz Award, the
18 Anti-Defamation League Humanitarian Award, and the Volunteer
19 Center of North Texas Servant Leader Award; a graduate of The
20 University of Texas at Austin, he has been named chair emeritus of
21 Lockton Dunning Benefits; and

22 WHEREAS, The strength and unity of our cities are enhanced by
23 the devoted efforts of individuals such as Thomas Dunning, whose
24 tireless work has contributed immeasurably to the quality of life

1 in Dallas; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
3 Legislature hereby congratulate Thomas M. Dunning on his receipt of
