- 3 that impressive milestone on May 6, 2015; and
- WHEREAS, Jesse Balthazar was born in 1915 in Natchitoches,
- 5 Louisiana, to Louis and Rosa Balthazar, and he moved with his mother
- 6 and two sisters to Houston at the age of nine; after graduating from
- 7 Phillis Wheatley High School, he went to work in a drugstore, and it
- 8 was while he was employed there that he met his future wife, the
- 9 former Vernice Frilot; the couple were married in 1941, only three
- 10 days before he left for basic training with the U.S. Army; and
- 11 WHEREAS, During World War II, Mr. Balthazar served with an
- 12 engineering battalion, and he endured extremes of climate, helping
- 13 to build a highway in Alaska and then serving in the tropical
- 14 jungles of New Guinea, where he contracted malaria; and
- WHEREAS, After the war, Mr. Balthazar built a home in
- 16 Houston's Fifth Ward with his father-in-law, and he and
- 17 Mrs. Balthazar still live there today, some 70 years later; now
- 18 retired, Mr. Balthazar enjoyed a rewarding career with the U.S.
- 19 Postal Service, and he became one of the first African American
- 20 supervisors in Houston's downtown post office; he also operated a
- 21 gas station and a variety store for a time with his wife and his
- 22 sister; Mr. and Mrs. Balthazar have both been active members of the
- 23 National Association of Retired Federal Employees; and
- 24 WHEREAS, A man of strong religious faith, Mr. Balthazar has

- 1 been a leading member of Our Mother of Mercy Catholic Church for
- 2 decades, helping to establish a men's choir, raising funds to build
- 3 a new building, and serving as cofounder of the church's credit
- 4 union, which he also managed for many years; he has been active as
- 5 well with the church's bazaar and golf tournament, and he is a
- 6 longtime member of the Knights of Columbus and the Knights of Peter
- 7 Claver; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Balthazar continues to enjoy listening to big
- 9 band music and the blues, swinging his golf club, fishing, working
- 10 in his yard, and taking care of his dog; he takes special pleasure
- 11 in the time he spends with his children, Jesse Jude, Sidney Louis,
- 12 and Irma Rose, and his grandchildren, Jesse, Tia, Craig, Jerrald,
- 13 Kimberly, Ann, Mamie, and Mary; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Blessed with a host of loved ones and sustained by
- 15 his strong faith, Jesse Balthazar has gracefully reached the
- 16 century mark and continues to enrich the lives of all those who are
- 17 fortunate enough to know him; now, therefore, be it
