

Suspending limitations on conference committee
jurisdiction, H.B. No. 483 (Capriglione/Kolkhorst)

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 84th Legislature, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be
3 suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to
4 enable the conference committee appointed to resolve the
5 differences on House Bill 483 (the establishment and administration
6 of a state bullion depository; authorizing fees) to consider and
7 take action on the following matters:

8 (1) House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1) and (3), are suspended
9 to permit the committee to add and amend text which is not in
10 disagreement in proposed SECTION 1 of the bill, in added Section
11 2116.015(a)(1), Government Code, to read as follows:

12 (1) an individual or fiduciary, including an
13 administrator, executor, custodian, guardian, or trustee;

14 Explanation: This change is necessary to ensure that an
15 individual may use a depository account in the state bullion
16 depository as an investment.

17 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit
18 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 1
19 of the bill, in added Section 2116.015, Government Code, by
20 omitting proposed Subsection (b), which reads as follows:

21 (b) An investment by an insurance company in a depository
22 account is eligible to be applied as a credit against taxes payable
23 under Chapters 221 and 222, Insurance Code, in accordance with
24 rules adopted by the comptroller after consultation with the

1 commissioner of insurance.

2 Explanation: The omission is necessary to eliminate the
3 implication that certain investments may be applied as tax credits.
