2 Ashwood suffered an immeasurable loss with the death of this heroic  
3 Texan on Memorial Day, May 25, 2015, at the age of 44; and

4           WHEREAS, Joe Ros exemplified bravery and selflessness,  
5 traits that were made evident on that fateful day, when he lost his  
6 own life while saving his children, Garrett, Grayson, Gaven, and  
7 Aubrey, who had been swept away in a riptide at Matagorda Beach; and

8           WHEREAS, A proud alumnus of Texas A&M University, Mr. Ros  
9 joined the United States National Guard in 1989 and served his  
10 country with distinction in Iraq, earning the rank of sergeant  
11 first class; he remained active in the Texas Army National Guard  
12 while pursuing a civilian career as an employee of the Van Vleck  
13 Independent School District, where he served as principal of O. H.  
14 Herman Middle School, assistant principal of Van Vleck High School,  
15 and director of maintenance and transportation; and

16           WHEREAS, Mr. Ros was deeply devoted to his faith and his  
17 family, which included his beloved wife, Ashley; he counted hunting  
18 and fishing among his passions, and he especially delighted in  
19 spending time in the outdoors with his loved ones; and

20           WHEREAS, Above all else, Joe Ros found joy in helping others,  
21 and those who were fortunate enough to share in the richness of his  
22 life will forever cherish their memories of this esteemed educator,  
23 caring family man, and true and loyal friend; now, therefore, be it
