## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, La Entrada al Pacifico is a state and federally 2 designated trade corridor that is designed to connect West Texas 3 with the Pacific port of Topolobampo in the state of Sinaloa, 4 Mexico; and

5 WHEREAS, The concept of this major new trade corridor, "the 6 Gateway to the Pacific," was envisioned in the 1990s to maximize the 7 opportunities created by the North American Free Trade Agreement; 8 it has been developed by a dynamic coalition that includes the 9 Midland-Odessa Transportation Alliance and the Departments of 10 Economic Development of the States of Chihuahua, Sinaloa, and 11 Durango; and

WHEREAS, In the past two decades, trade with Mexico has 12 continued to grow, and this new corridor will increase trade 13 14 between West Texas and Chihuahua, one of the Lone Star State's largest export markets; moreover, it will link the Midland-Odessa 15 area with the Pacific Rim and East Asian nations 16 through Topolobampo, a closer and less expensive alternative to the crowded 17 Port of Los Angeles, and it will ease pressure on the highly 18 congested international crossing at El Paso; and 19

20 WHEREAS, The corridor will offer enormous opportunities in 21 the Permian Basin and beyond for commercial growth in warehousing, 22 distribution, manufacturing, and assembly; many cities located 23 along Interstate Highways 20 and 10 stand to benefit, among them 24 Abilene, Fort Worth, and Dallas; and
