20 member of the boards of Alon USA Energy, Trinity Industries, and
21 Petron Corporation; active over the years in both industry and
22 civic organizations in Dallas, he has been the recipient of
23 numerous well-deserved honors for his achievements; and

2 respect and admiration, and Ron Haddock may take justifiable pride
3 in all that he has accomplished through his hard work and
