1 WHEREAS, Acclaimed singer and songwriter Miranda Lambert
2 collected four trophies at the 50th annual Academy of Country Music
3 Awards held in Arlington on April 19, 2015; and

4 WHEREAS, An 18-time winner going into this year's event,
5 Ms. Lambert shone brightly yet again on one of country music's
6 biggest nights; she took home accolades for Female Vocalist of the
7 Year, Album of the Year for *Platinum*, and Song of the Year for
8 "Automatic," and she was one of just seven recipients of the 50th
9 Anniversary Milestone Award, which recognized her notable
10 achievement of being the most awarded solo female artist in the
11 program's history; and

12 WHEREAS, A native of Lindale, Ms. Lambert embarked on her
13 career as a recording artist with her independently issued
14 self-titled debut in 2001, and she has since recorded five
15 major-label releases, all of which have reached number one; a
16 mainstay on the hit parade, this platinum-selling singer has scored
17 17 top-20 hits, including four chart-toppers, and has won 2 Grammy
18 Awards, 4 CMT Music Awards, and 12 Country Music Association
19 Awards; and

20 WHEREAS, Miranda Lambert has blazed her own path in the genre
21 throughout her stellar career, expanding the boundaries of outlaw
22 country as a strong voice for female empowerment, and it is a
23 pleasure to honor her for her significant contributions to the
24 musical heritage of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
