

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, That House Rule 13,
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 11 (the carrying of handguns
6 on the campuses of and certain other locations associated with
7 institutions of higher education; providing a criminal penalty) to
8 consider and take action on the following matters:

9 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit
10 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in SECTION 1 of the
11 bill, by omitting added Sections 411.2031(f) and (g), Government
12 Code. The omitted text prohibits carrying a concealed handgun on
13 the premises of a hospital maintained or operated by an institution
14 of higher education or private or independent institution of higher
15 education or the premises of certain schools located on the campus
16 of such an institution, if certain signs are posted.

17 Explanation: The omission of the text is necessary to remove
18 a requirement that certain signs be posted to prohibit the carrying
19 of concealed handguns on the premises of a hospital maintained or
20 operated by an institution of higher education or private or
21 independent institution of higher education or the premises of
22 certain schools located on the campus of such an institution.

23 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit
24 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in SECTION 3 of the

1 bill, in amended Section 46.03, Penal Code, by omitting added
2 Subsections (j) and (k). The omitted text prohibits carrying a
3 concealed handgun on the premises of a hospital maintained or
4 operated by an institution of higher education or private or
5 independent institution of higher education or the premises of
6 certain schools located on the campus of such an institution, if
7 certain signs are posted.

8 Explanation: The omission of the text is necessary to remove
9 a requirement that certain signs be posted to prohibit the carrying
10 of concealed handguns on the premises of a hospital maintained or
11 operated by an institution of higher education or private or
12 independent institution of higher education or the premises of
13 certain schools located on the campus of such an institution.
