Awareness Week, a nationwide campaign to inform the public about

4 WHEREAS, Fires and burns are one of the leading causes of

5 accidental death and morbidity in the United States; millions of

6 Americans are victims of some type of burn injury each year,

7 including tens of thousands that require serious medical care;

8 severe burns are considered by many to be the most painful and

9 traumatic type of injury, as these burns often require a long and

10 complex series of treatments, taking a devastating toll on a

11 patient's quality of life; and

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12 WHEREAS, The risk of burn injury is greatest in the home, as

13 many common household activities and appliances carry the potential

14 for burns; children and aging adults are especially likely to

15 sustain scald injuries from hot liquids or foods, and burns can also

16 result from contact with electricity or corrosive chemicals; and

WHEREAS, Texas is home to a number of state-of-the-art burn

18 centers that are specifically equipped to meet the challenges

19 associated with burn treatment and rehabilitation; Shriners

20 Hospitals for Children, which operates a renowned burn institute in

21 Galveston, is dedicated to providing advanced burn care to children

22 in need regardless of their families' ability to pay, and the

23 organization additionally conducts vital research and prevention

24 efforts with the goal of lowering the incidence of burn injury and
