1 WHEREAS, Rodrigo Ramon Jr. completed his noteworthy tenure as
2 mayor of Robstown in May 2015, and it is indeed fitting to recognize
3 him for his contributions to his community; and

4 WHEREAS, First elected in 2001, Mr. Ramon ably guided the
5 city with a strong focus on infrastructure and economic
6 development; he oversaw improvements to streets and utilities, as
7 well as the renovation of the fire and police stations, and he

19 exceptional dedication to the betterment of his hometown, and his
20 accomplishments will continue to benefit his fellow citizens in the
21 years to come; now, therefore, be it

24 mayor of Robstown and extend to him sincere best wishes for the
