A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the allocation to the state highway fund and the
- 3 available school fund of certain motor vehicle sales, use, and
- 4 rental tax revenue and to the uses of the revenue allocated to the
- 5 state highway fund.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 152, Tax Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Section 152.1223 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 152.1223. ALLOCATION OF CERTAIN TAX REVENUE TO STATE
- 10 HIGHWAY FUND. (a) This section applies only to money that:
- 11 (1) the comptroller receives in a state fiscal year
- 12 that begins on or after September 1, 2017;
- 13 (2) is received under Sections 152.043, 152.045,
- 14 152.047, and 152.121, is derived from the taxes imposed under
- 15 Sections 152.021, 152.022, 152.023, 152.026, and 152.028, and is
- 16 remaining after the comptroller makes the allocation required by
- 17 Section 152.1222; and
- 18 (3) exceeds the first \$2.5 billion of the money
- 19 described by Subdivisions (1) and (2) that is received in that state
- 20 fiscal year.
- 21 (b) Notwithstanding Section 152.122, the comptroller shall
- 22 deposit the money to which this section applies as follows:
- 23 (1) the comptroller shall deposit all money received
- 24 to the credit of the state highway fund until a total of \$2.5

- 1 billion has been deposited to the fund under this subdivision in the
- 2 state fiscal year; and
- 3 (2) the comptroller shall deposit any additional money
- 4 received in the state fiscal year as follows:
- 5 (A) fifty percent to the credit of the state
- 6 <u>highway fund;</u>
- 7 (B) thirty percent to the credit of the general
- 8 revenue fund; and
- 9 (C) twenty percent to the credit of the available
- 10 school fund.
- 11 (c) Money deposited to the credit of the state highway fund
- 12 under this section may be appropriated only to:
- 13 (1) construct, maintain, or acquire rights-of-way for
- 14 public roadways other than toll roads; or
- 15 (2) repay the principal of and interest on general
- obligation bonds issued as authorized by Section 49-p, Article III,
- 17 Texas Constitution.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
