performance. An overall or indicator performance rating of B 20

An overall or indicator [and a district] performance rating of D or 23

24 F reflects unacceptable performance. [The commissioner shall also

- 1 assign each campus a performance rating of exemplary, recognized, 2 acceptable, or unacceptable. A campus performance rating of exemplary, recognized, or acceptable reflects acceptable 3 4 performance, and a campus performance rating of unacceptable reflects unacceptable performance.] A district may not receive an 5 overall or indicator [a] performance rating of A if the district 6 7 includes any campus with a <u>corresponding overall or indicator</u> performance rating of D or F [unacceptable]. A reference in law to 8 an acceptable rating or acceptable performance includes an overall 9 or indicator performance rating of A or B or exemplary or recognized 10 11 performance.
- (a-1) Not later than August 8 of each year, the performance 12 13 ratings [rating] of each district and campus shall be made publicly as provided by rules adopted under this 14 available If a district or campus received <u>an overall or</u> 15 [subsection]. 16 indicator [a] performance rating of D or F [that reflected unacceptable performance] for the preceding school year, the 17 commissioner shall notify the district of a subsequent such 18 designation on or before June 15. 19
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 21 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
