2 SECTION 2. The amendment made by this Act to Section 3 5A(a)(5), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, 4 Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil 5 Statutes), is intended only to clarify existing law with respect to 6 the eligibility of certain events to receive funding from the Major 7 Events trust fund.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
