| 3 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 4 | SECTION 1. Section 366.178(b-1), Transportation Code, is |
| 5 | amended to read as follows: |
| 6 | (b-1) As an alternative to requiring payment of a toll at |
| 7 | the time a vehicle is driven or towed through a toll assessment |
| 8 | facility, the authority shall use video recordings, photography, |
| 9 | electronic data, transponders, or other tolling methods to permit |
| 10 | the registered owner of the nonpaying vehicle to pay the toll at a |
| 11 | later date or provide toll exemptions. Information collected under |
| 12 | this subsection, including contact, payment and other account |
| 13 | information and trip data, is confidential and not subject to |
| 14 | disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code. |
| 15 | SECTION 2. Sections 366.179(a) and (d), Transportation |

- 16 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) For purposes of this section, a transponder is a device 18 placed on or within a motor vehicle [an automobile] that is capable 19 of transmitting or receiving information used to assess or collect 20 tolls or provide toll exemptions. A transponder is insufficiently 21 funded if there is no money in the account for which the transponder 22 was issued.
- 23 (d) Transponder [customer] account information, including 24 contact and payment information and trip data, is confidential and

- 1 not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 372.102(a), Transportation Code, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) Notwithstanding the confidentiality of electronic toll
- 5 collection customer account information, including confidentiality
- 6 under Sections 228.057(e), 366.178(b-1), 366.179(d), and
- 7 370.178(d), a toll project entity may publish a list of the names of
- 8 the registered owners or lessees of nonpaying vehicles who at the
- 9 time of publication are liable for the payment of past due and
- 10 unpaid tolls or administrative fees. The list may include only the
- 11 persons' names and, for each person listed:
- 12 (1) the city and state of the person's residence;
- 13 (2) the total number of events of nonpayment; and
- 14 (3) the total amount due for the tolls and
- 15 administrative fees.
- SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 17 a request for information that is received by a regional tollway
- 18 authority on or after the effective date of this Act. A request for
- 19 information that was received before the effective date of this Act
- 20 is governed by the law in effect on the date the request was
- 21 received, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 22 purpose.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
