5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2155, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2155.1443 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2155.1443. EXEMPTION FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY FAMILY
8	VIOLENCE CENTER OR FAMILY VIOLENCE SPECIAL PROJECT. (a) The
9	competitive bidding provisions of this chapter do not apply to a
10	state purchase of services that meets the specifications for
11	services prescribed by Section 51.005, Human Resources Code, and
12	<pre>provided by:</pre>
13	(1) a family violence center, as that term is defined
14	by Section 51.002, Human Resources Code; or
15	(2) a family violence special project, as that term is
16	defined by Section 51.002, Human Resources Code.
17	(b) The Health and Human Services Commission shall procure
18	services for victims of family violence as provided by Chapter 51,
19	Human Resources Code, in consultation with a statewide family
20	violence organization and in a manner consistent with the plan for
21	delivering family violence services under Section 51.0021, Human
22	Resources Code.
