## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to an exemption from competitive bidding requirements for 3 the procurement of services for victims of family violence.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 51.004, Human Resources
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 51.004. CONTRACT <u>ELIGIBILITY; PROCUREMENT;</u>
8 APPLICATION PROCESS [BIDS].

9 SECTION 2. Section 51.004, Human Resources Code, is amended 10 by amending Subsection (e), as amended by S.B. 219, Acts of the 84th 11 Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, and by adding Subsections (f) 12 and (g) to read as follows:

13 (e) The commission shall use a noncompetitive procurement 14 procedure to award a contract under Section 51.003(a) or (b) if the commission determines that there is no competition between eligible 15 16 family violence centers for services or a service area. If the commission determines that there is competition between eligible 17 family violence centers for services or a service area, the 18 commission shall award a contract under Section 51.003(a) or (b) 19 through an application process that considers the eligibility 20 21 requirements and other factors provided in this section and allocates the money in accordance with this chapter and with 22 23 consideration of the family violence services plan under Section

24 <u>51.0021</u> [a competitive procurement procedure].

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(f) The commission shall consult with a statewide family 1 violence organization to develop the application process described 2 in Subsection (e) but may not involve the organization in the 3 contract selection or award process. 4 5 (g) To the extent of any conflict between this section and 6 any other law, including Chapter 2155, Government Code, this 7 section controls. SECTION 3. Section 51.003(d), Human Resources Code, 8 as amended by S.B. 219, Acts of the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 9 10 2015, is repealed. SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 11 a contract awarded on or after the effective date of this Act. 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16

17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
