5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is

9 <u>In this section, "nurse" means a nurse licensed under Chapter 301,</u>

amended by adding Section 38.020 to read as follows:

- (b) A public school, including an open-enrollment charter

 school, that does not have a full-time nurse or the equivalent of a

 full-time nurse assigned to be present on the campus for more than

 30 consecutive instructional days during the same school year shall

 provide written notice of the absence of a nurse to the parent of or

 other person standing in parental relation to each student enrolled

 in the school.
- 18 <u>(c) A school has the equivalent of a full-time nurse under</u>
 19 <u>Subsection (b) if the school has two or more nurses assigned to the</u>
 20 <u>school and those nurses' combined presence covers all regular</u>
 21 <u>student instructional hours at a campus during the regular school</u>
 22 day.
- 23 (d) The principal of the school shall provide the notice 24 required by Subsection (b) not later than the 30th instructional

- 1 day after the first day the school does not have a full-time nurse
- 2 <u>assigned to be present on the campus.</u>
- 3 (e) The school shall:
- 4 (1) make a good faith effort to ensure that the notice
- 5 required by this section is provided in a bilingual form to any
- 6 parent or other person standing in parental relation whose primary
- 7 <u>language is not English; and</u>
- 8 (2) retain a copy of any notice provided under this
- 9 section.
- 10 (f) A school may satisfy the notice requirement under
- 11 Subsection (d) by posting the notice on the school's Internet
- 12 website. Notice posted under this subsection must be accessible
- 13 from the home page of the Internet website by use of not more than
- 14 three links.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
