- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 708.151(c), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) If on or before the 45th day after the date the first
- 8 notice was sent the person fails to pay the amount of the surcharge
- 9 or fails to enter into an installment payment agreement with the
- 10 department, the department shall send a second notice. [If on or
- 11 before the 60th day after the date the second notice was sent the
- 12 person fails to pay the amount of the surcharge or fails to enter
- 13 into an installment payment agreement with the department, the
- 14 department shall send a third notice that advises the person that
- 15 the person's driving privileges are suspended.
- SECTION 2. Section 708.154, Transportation Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 708.154. CREDIT CARD PAYMENT OF SURCHARGE. [(a)] The
- 19 department by rule may authorize the payment of a surcharge by use
- 20 of a credit card. The rules shall require the person to pay all
- 21 costs incurred by the department in connection with the acceptance
- 22 of the credit card.
- 23 [(b) If a surcharge or a related cost is paid by credit card
- 24 and the amount is subsequently reversed by the issuer of the credit

- 1 card, the license of the person is automatically suspended.
- 2 [(c) A license suspended under this section remains
- 3 suspended until the person pays the amount of the surcharge and any
- 4 related costs.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 708.152, Transportation Code, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
